The Colorado Nurses Foundation is a 501(c)(3) not-for-profit organization dedicated to improving health care and nursing practice in Colorado. We encourage nurses, other health care providers, and consumers to join us to work together for quality health care. With donations from the Nightingale event and other community members, CNF has awarded 319 scholarships totaling \$409,750 since 1999.

Nightingale—The Last 25 Years

The Nightingale Awards event was founded in 1985 to honor nurses who best exemplify the philosophy and practice of Florence Nightingale, a 19th century nursing pioneer who epitomized the art of helping people toward their optimal health. Registered Nurses throughout the state are nominated by solicitation from the Colorado Area Health Education Centers System (AHEC), the Colorado Springs Committee and the Western Slope Committee in the fall of each year. Each region hosts a local event for nominees. Local event dates are available upon request.

Finalists are selected by the regions and the State Selection Committee then determines the recipients. The announcement of the recipients at the Nightingale event is a highlight of the evening. Recipients receive a commemorative Nightingale bronze sculpture crafted by Colorado artist Jan Searle-Kubby.

Our Goal

The goal of the Nightingale event is to recognize outstanding Colorado nurses, and raise funds for scholarships and educational activities for nurses throughout the state.

2012 Nightingale Luminary Awards

The Colorado Nurses Foundation announces the second year of the revised Nightingale Awards Program which provides for state level recognition of a greater number of nurses while retaining the six traditional Nightingale award designees. The regional award recipients are designated as luminaries and up to 48 luminaries as selected from their regions will be honored at the state recognition event.

The Luminaries (regional level) and the Nightingale Award Recipients (state level) will be in two categories:

Category I: Nurses in Clinical Practice

Category II: Administrators, Educators, Researchers, and Non-Traditional Practice Roles

Areas of recognition in EACH category will be: Nurses who made a difference for their profession, their patients or their communities through

Advocacy—advancing a cause or proposal

Leadership—motivating others to work toward a common goal

Innovation—demonstrating creativity which addresses today's challenges/opportunities

The event will be held on Saturday, May 19, 2012 at the Westin Westminster. Those who attend find it an inspiring and renewing experience—a great final event following the celebration of National Nurses Week!

The Nightingale Luminary theme of excellence in nursing professional engagement and citizenship reflects the CNF Strategic Initiative to reframe the profession of nursing and the professional engagement of nurses.
